BETTER TOGETHER



Since its launch in April, Better Together has brought over 200 ambassadors committed to supporting the mothers in Liberia who cannot afford healthcare for their children. The program's kickoff raised over \$10,000 to fund life-saving surgery for Melvin, a young boy with a critical need, showcasing the immediate impact of this collective effort.

Through in-home gatherings, monthly Zoom calls, and hosting Chief Medical Officer Dr. Mikey Bryant in Cartersville, ambassadors have built a strong community dedicated to advancing LIVE2540's mission. These women are proving that when they unite, lives are transformed, and hope is restored. Better Together is more than a program—it's a growing movement of compassion and change.



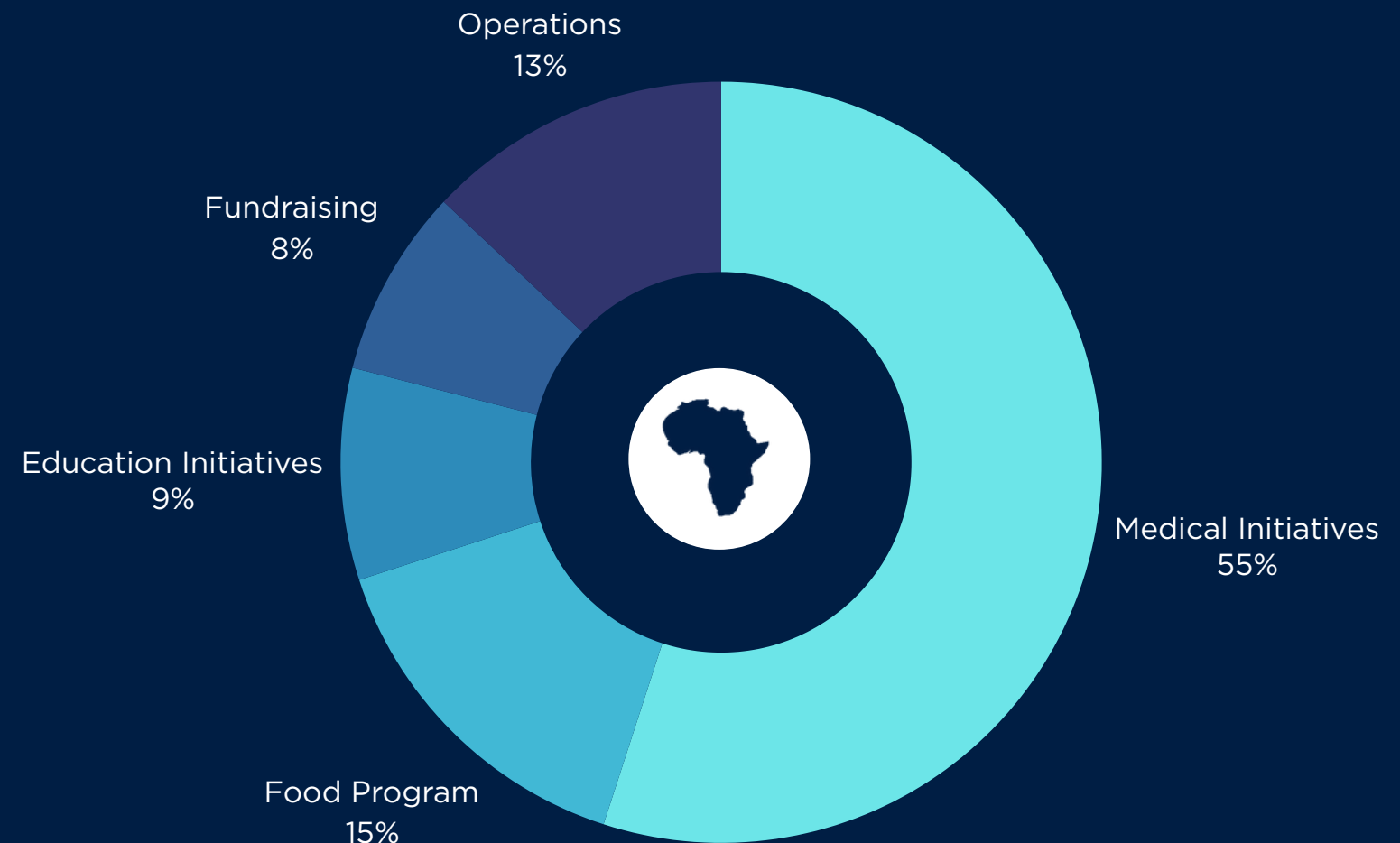
HER STORY THEIR FUTURES

We first met a little girl named Theresa at a bush clinic in 2019. She was convulsing on the floor, too weak to open her eyes or cry. Although rushed to ELWA hospital two hours away, it was too late —Theresa eventually passed away from cerebral malaria. Her passing was one of many that fueled the vision and building of what is now the Jesus Loves Me Children's Center.

When our inpatient ward opened this October, a little girl named Rachel arrived at the Jesus Loves Me Children's Center in a similar condition. Like Theresa, Rachel was convulsing from severe malaria. This time, with our clinic close by, the team of doctors and nurses were able to act quickly. Rachel was stabilized within a day and discharged by the end of the week. The impact of Jesus Loves Me Children's Center is just beginning to unfold, but stories like Rachel's show the life-saving difference it's already making.

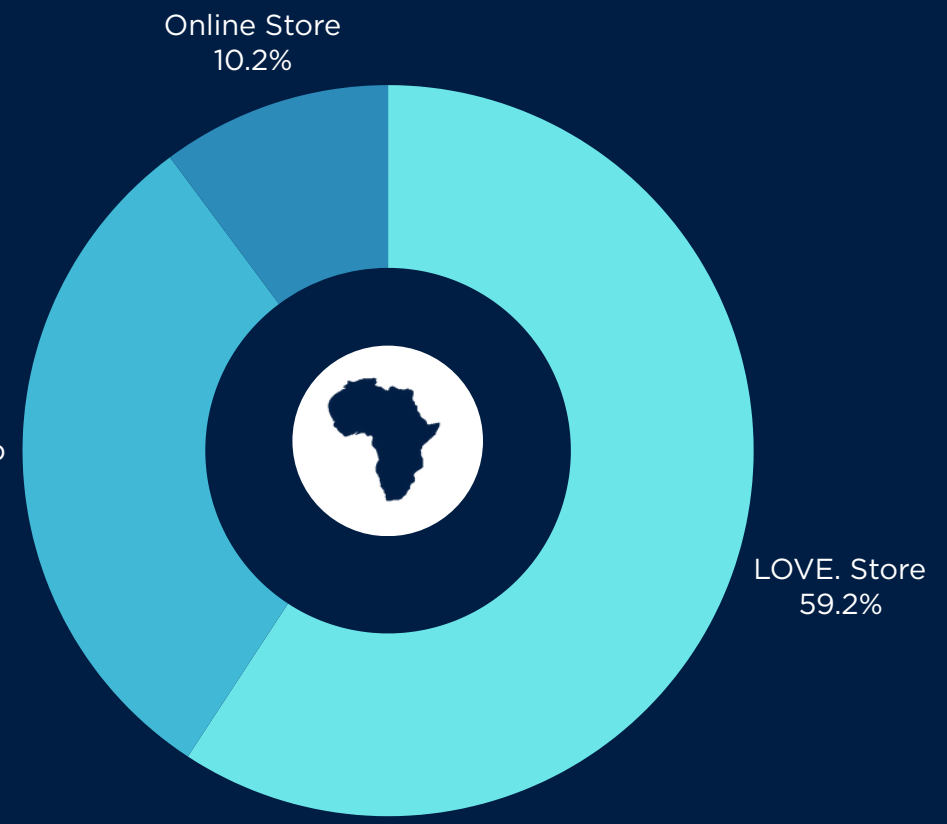
PROGRAM EXPENSE PERCENTAGES
